RULES & REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be judged in accordance therewith.

While every attempt has been made to avoid mistakes in this prize list, publication, website and/or email, Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic, its management and employees assume no liability for errors. Any significant errors or changes will be disclosed to competitors whose entries are accepted in accordance with USEF Rules.

2023 USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT: I have read the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") Entry Agreement (GR906.4) as printed in the Prize List for Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic ("Competition") and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Federation Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos from the competition, and agree that any actions against the Federation must be brought in New York State. The complete statement is as follows:

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE (GR407.1-3) For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs).

USHJA Zone Fee: \$7 per entry.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Motorized Vehicles: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single 10 wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/ legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs/other mobility assist devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS AND MEASUREMENT CARDS: To be eligible to compete at Federation Licensed Competitions, coaches, trainers, and legal guardians signing as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing, as defined herein. All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Amateur certification, and measurement cards for Junior Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued. Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. Measurements will be conducted on Thursday at 3:00pm or by special arrangement.

HORSE IDENTIFICATION AND RECORDING: All horses competing in Federation licensed competitions must be properly identified. For all such competitions, entries for each horse must include either a Federation-issued Unique Horse Identification Number or a registration number from a Federation Recognized Affiliate. Additionally, a Federation Recognized Discipline Affiliate may require horses to be registered with their organization, and if so, the entry must also include that registration number. 2. The Federation will issue only one Unique Horse ID Number per horse. This Unique Horse ID number must subsequently remain with the horse in perpetuity, and shall not be changed for any reason, including upgrade from Unique Horse ID to a Recording, change of ownership, change of name, or death, 3, Prior to submitting an application for a new Unique Horse ID number, it is the owner's responsibility to verify the current ID status of a horse through a Horse Recording/ID search, (the assistance of Federation staff may be requested). Anyone who knowingly seeks to obtain an additional Unique Horse ID Number for a horse which has previously been issued one is subject to disciplinary action. 4. The Federation must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. 5. Owners are requested to notify the Federation of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings. 6. A Unique Horse ID number can be upgraded to Federation recording. The Unique Horse ID Number will remain the same. 7. Applications for Unique Horse ID Numbers and/or recordings can be completed online at www.usef.org using the Horse application form which can also be downloaded. The ID application form is also available on request from the Federation office, and from competition management. 8. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors in their prize lists of the Unique Horse ID Number requirement, and availability of Horse ID Number application forms. 9. There will be no charge for Unique Horse ID Numbers that are issued via the internet to members of USEF or its affiliates for: 1) horses that are life recorded, registered or otherwise identified or listed with a USEF discipline affiliate, or 2) horses registered with a USEF breed affiliate. Horses not meeting the above criteria must have a completed USEF Horse application indicating on the application the request for a Horse ID before a number will be issued. This form can be completed on the internet, free of charge, at www.usef.org

USHJA Horse Registrations. All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA (exception: opportunity, academy, exhibition, walk-trot and lead line). A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms **MICROCHIPPING.** All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions. Exceptions: USHJA Outreach and those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9.

HORSE/PONY HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All animals entering the show grounds, whether competing or for schooling only, must present a current negative Coggins test dated within a year of that competition. Per USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation Licensed Competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus & Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopheumonitis) vaccinations within six months of entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule will be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. NO EXCEPTIONS!

ENTRIES: Competitors are required to submit their show entries online at http://www.horseshowsonline.com/

Entries will close June 30, 2023. ANY ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER 5PM on CLOSING DATE WILL BE CHARGED A \$20 LATE FEE FOR OPENING WEEK SHOW; \$50 LATE FEE FOR USEF RATED SHOW. Entries will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner or his exhibitor's agent, trainer and rider and accompanied by a check or credit card. Be sure to include the USEF/USHJA Membership Numbers of your trainer, rider and Owner's USEF/USHJA Membership Numbers on the entry form. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order and form of payment received. All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. Non-member USHJA fee \$30 to USHJA.

NEW – USEF SHOW PASS FEE: Effective 12-1-2022 any rider, handler, driver, or owner are limited to one USEF Show Pass purchase annually (December 1-November 30). USEF Show Pass will be available for purchase by exhibitors online only. USEF Membership will be required in order to compete for anyone who has not purchased a Show Pass through their USEF portal. Trainers and Coaches are no longer eligible to participate under a Show Pass and must be an Active USEF member.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS: A processing fee of \$50.00 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable check.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: All horses on the grounds are required to have a signed entry form in the office, whether showing or non-showing. This entry form must include signatures and a complete description of the horse. Non-Showing horses will pay a non-showing fee of \$50 Opening Week / \$100 Rated Week.

NIGHT WATCH: (USEF RATED WEEK) All horses occupying a stall (showing or non-showing) will be charged a \$25 Night Watch Fee.

MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if insufficient entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with GR914. Divisions will be combined based on USEF rules. PLEASE NOTE: Concerning splitting/combining and add/scratch policies in all Rated hunter sections – should entries warrant, all Rated hunter sections will be split or combined following USEF rules and will be done so at the close of the horse show office on the evening preceding the first class in each section, therefore entries must be completed for the Rated hunter divisions accordingly to be considered. Any post adds received and accepted after this time will not be considered in respect to the splitting/combining. There will be no exceptions to this policy. Same day scratches and/or no shows at the gate in all Rated hunter sections will forfeit their entry fee unless the official show veterinarian supplies a certificate warranting a scratch from the show. This certificate must be received by the official show secretary prior to the section in question. Should same day scratches and/or no shows result in insufficient entries to keep sections split, sections will be combined.

RESPONSIBILITY: The Chagrin Hunter Jumper Classic and Chagrin Valley Farms, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. **THIS WILL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS**

PRIZE MONEY will be credited to show bills or paid within 30 days following the conclusion of the show via check. Prize money and refunds will be made payable to the owner of the horse unless otherwise indicated in writing to the show office. A valid SSN or Tax ID information is required for all payments. A FORM W9 is required to be presented for all exhibitors. *Please note, tax identification numbers are required to pay out horse show prize money. Prize money will be forfeited for exhibitors who do not wish to provide this information.*

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from the official show veterinarian. **Office & stall fees are nonrefundable.**

SHOW OFFICE will be open the day prior to the start of the show from 9am to 5 pm. Show Office will open on Show Days 1 hour prior to the start of the show and close at 5 pm. Adds/Scratches for the following day must be submitted by 4 pm the previous day. NO ADDS/SCRATCHES AT THE INGATE.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS. All Hunter Classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an under-saddle class. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the two horses which have acquired the most points in each Hunter, Jumper & Equitation section. Three classes must be held in order to award champions. All Rated Hunter sections will be combined as necessary according to current USEF rules.

JUMPER ORDER. A rotating jumping order may be established for all classes over fences. Management reserves the right to draw and post an order of go. Riders or trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

STABLING. 180 - 10 x 10 vinyl-sided stalls with doors, dirt floor, some mats, in a permanent barn. Stall Fees: \$125 for Opening Week Show and \$225 for USEF Rated Show. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Please remember to bring buckets. Stalls will be available Wednesday July 5, 2023, after 3pm for Opening Show. Must vacate stalls by 9am Monday, July 10, 2023. Stalls will be available for Rated Show Tuesday, July 11, 2023 after 3pm. Stalls must be vacated by 8am Monday, July 17, 2023. STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED. No alterations are to be made to stabling.

HAY & BEDDING will be charged at market price plus labor cost. Orders must be given to the show secretary by 1:00 each day for delivery the following day. Please call Linda Joseph at (440) 488-8777, to pre-order.

FOOTING AND ARENA SIZES: Hunter rings are 130' by 260' with SRS footing by Footing First. Schooling ring is a limestone/sand mixture. Jumper ring is 200' by 300' with SRS footing by Footing First. Jumper schooling is SRS footing.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS Current USEF rules and regulations regarding D & M will be enforced. Sharps and medical waste must be disposed of in sharps containers placed around the barns. All competitors are asked to comply with the USEF Testing Veterinarians in a courteous and efficient manner. Please note that sharps containers MUST be used as provided or penalties will occur. (GR1210.4) All showing horses will be invoiced the USEF D & M and USEF Fee of \$23.

SCHOOLING AND WARM-UP: ALL horses must be entered with paperwork completed/on file with show office prior to schooling. FOR RATED SHOW BACK #s MUST BE WORN for ticketed schooling (\$25). Additional ticketed schooling may be allowed, weather permitting in the afternoons on show days. Hacking/Hand walking in the hunter rings will be allowed up to approximately 45 min before official showtime (weather pending). No flatting in the jumper ring at any time after schooling day unless otherwise specified with management. THERE WILL BE NO SCHOOLING IN THE RINGS ON THE MORNINGS OF SHOW DAYS. Approved hard hats must be worn with chin-straps fastened whenever mounted. No poling or offset oxers will be allowed at any time.

HEAD GEAR: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent, guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE: * Earbuds or earphones are prohibited in any areas designated for schooling and exercise including lunging areas. * All riders and attendants must be neatly and appropriately attired when entering the ring. * No smoking is permitted in any buildings. * Dogs must be leashed at all times. Per USEF Rule GR1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. * The area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory line that will be indicated on the course diagram and a corresponding barrier will be erected on the course. * Children must be supervised at all times. *Horses will be allowed in the show rings only at such hours announced by management.. * Lunging only in designated areas.*

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: All adult members and participants who have regular contact with or authority over minor athletes must be in compliance with the SafeSport Training for eligibility to participate. All participants who are members must be checked against the SafeSport Training ineligibility list. This can be done by comparing the participant list against the ineligibility list published on the USEF website or automatically by initiating an API data transfer. Non-member participants required to satisfy the training requirements must show proof of completion by either producing a certificate of completion or be verified through the USEF Safe Sport Directory, which includes everyone currently compliant with the training requirement. Any participant on the ineligibility list for failure to take or refresh their training cannot participate in any role other than as a spectator. USEF thanks you for participating in this competition and your support of USEF's continuous efforts to provide the safest environment possible for our athletes and other participants. Strategies for safeguarding athletes continue to evolve, and we are fully committed to keeping pace with best practices. The purpose of this letter is to remind you that you are bound by the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies, also known as the MAAPP. This includes the SafeSport Training requirement for adult members and participants who have regular contact with or authority over minor athletes. Additionally, please be reminded about reporting obligations. Any concerns that are non-sexual in nature, please use the USEF Safe Sport Incident Reporting Form available on the USEF website. Concerns or suspicions regarding sexual misconduct must be reported to https://safesport.isight.com/portal and the authorities if a minor is involved. All of this information can be found in the USEF Safe Sport Policy. Please take a moment to review the new USEF Safe Sport web pages on the USEF website to find comprehensive resources regarding USEF Safe Sport efforts. 
